Green Spaces Overview

PLACEMENT LENGTH AND DETAILS

- 3-4-month summer placements in parks and other natural settings, 30-37.5 hours/week
- Primarily outdoors, but some aspects of the job can be done in an indoor/office environment

PROGRAMME CYCLE START/END

- May 1 to August 31, 2018

REQUIREMENTS BEFORE PLACEMENT IS SECURE

- Job description has been approved
- Personal Information Form has confirmed eligibility
- Employer and Participant Agreements have been completed and signed

SUBSIDY DETAILS

- **50% of wage**, based on total wage of \$17.11; UNA-Canada's contribution is maximum of **\$8.55/hour** (organizations can pay more than \$17.11, but UNA-Canada's contribution would cap out at \$8.55/hour), and
- **50% of Mandatory Employment Related Costs (MERCs)**, which are CPP, EI, and vacation pay, based on MERC rate of **11.232%**

PARTICIPANT ELIGIBILITY

- Currently enrolled students who will return back to school at the end of their placement
- Aged 15-30
- Must be Canadian citizens, permanent residents, or those who have been granted refugee status in Canada
- Must not have completed another government-funded youth programme in the past year

EMPLOYER ELIGIBILITY

- Non-profits, private companies, post-secondary institutions, Indigenous-based organizations, governments, and other associations who are working in the green sector
