Members serve two-year terms and support stewardship efforts such as planning, protecting, and interpreting the Township's cultural resources.

The Recreation, Culture, and Parks Advisory Committee provides input on leisure services. Members serve two-year terms.

The Seniors Advisory Committee gives seniors a voice on issues such as transportation, affordability, recreation, and service delivery.

Both one-year and two-year terms are available for the seniors committee which also has a youth position for applicants aged 16 to 24.
